Day 3: Development and comorbidities

« we must not allow pockets of success to result in professional apathy »

Observations

Importance of early ART in context of cognitive function, hepatitis, malignancies, cardiac lesions ...

Early testing, improved access, ... give better future QoL and health (there is a positive future)

Action points

More research, more involvement, better access to services Early access to treatment, care, testing





Day 3: sexual and reproductive health

- « fuck without fear »
- « healthy, happy, hot »

Observations

Know your rights
Know what to do when things go wrong
Allow young people access to all services when they have sex

Action points

We need to work on disclosure to partners
We need to support health professional to talk about sex with PLHIV
Educate and inform (sexual life, PrEP, ...) professionals and PEERS





Day 3: adherence and doctorpatient relationship

- « how do YOU feel »
- « HIV can not be the first question »

Observations

Confidentiality, consent, capacity
People with chronic conditions show increased risk behaviour
Repeat your messages at regular times (ART is not everything)
Main barrier is normal life

Action points

Bring peer support into the care setting Support peers in providing support Collect good practices
